You may describe a specific experience or experiences in your life that will help you become a contributing member of the Advanced. Remember, this is your opportunity to introduce yourself, to discuss a meaningful event at length, to highlight your personal strengths, and to provide any additional information you would like us to consider in evaluating your application. The quality and effectiveness of your written communication will also be noticed.
