Services Offered

Services are confidential and most are provided free of charge to all students, both resident and commuter, on both an appointment and walk-in basis and include:

- unlimited office visits
- treatment of medical problems
- first aid
- suture removal
- blood pressure screening
- pregnancy testing and urinalysis
- glucometer blood sugar testing
- allergy injections-by appointment only. The student must provide the serum with specific orders from the allergist.
- loan of crutches for a two-week period. Cost of an unreturned item will be charged to the student.
- condoms and STD information and referral
- resource information on health related subjects
- TB Testing (\$10.00)
- Meningitis vaccine (\$115.00)
- Meningitis B vaccine (\$320)
- Flu Shot (\$20)

The required health documents must be completed on the Student Health Portal. To register, you will need your Student ID (include the @) and your westliberty.edu email address. Once you register for the portal, check your email to create a password. Once you create a password, you will be prompted to log in to the portal. When you use the portal you are accessing your own health information, do not share your log in credentials. After logging in, please complete all pending forms. Failure to complete these forms can result in being denied treatment at Student Health Services.

Referrals: The medical staff makes referrals to other agencies for health care not provided at Student Health Services or Doctors Urgent Care of Wheeling. Students are strongly urged to carry health insurance to cover any cost of such referrals.

Absences due to Illness: Students too ill to attend class can report to Student Health to get verification of the illness. This is not an excuse to miss class and is not given in all circumstances.

Doctors Urgent Care: A student unable to see the physician on campus may go to Doctors Urgent Care (hours listed at left). Doctors Urgent Care will bill your insurance for X-Rays, labs, and special procedures. All in-office charges not covered by insurance will be written off. If you do not have insurance, all in-office charges will be written off. Certain labs or X-rays sent to an outside facility cannot be written off by Doctors Urgent Care. You and/or your insurance will be billed for services outside of Doctors Urgent Care.
