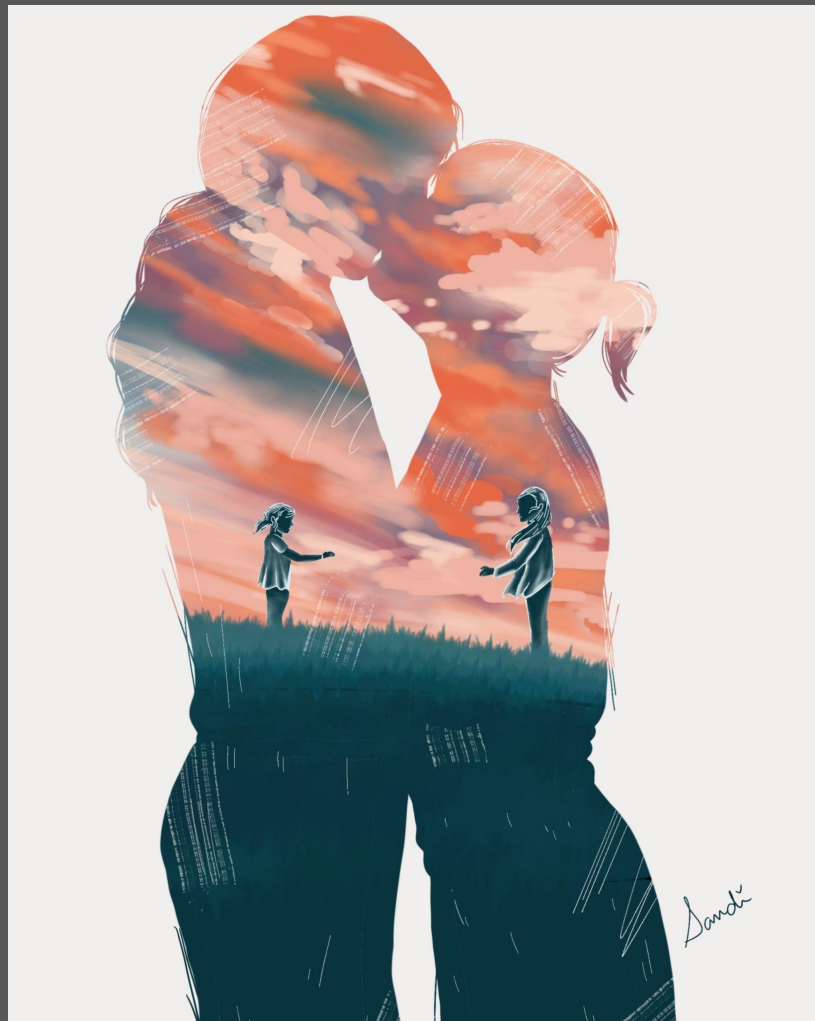

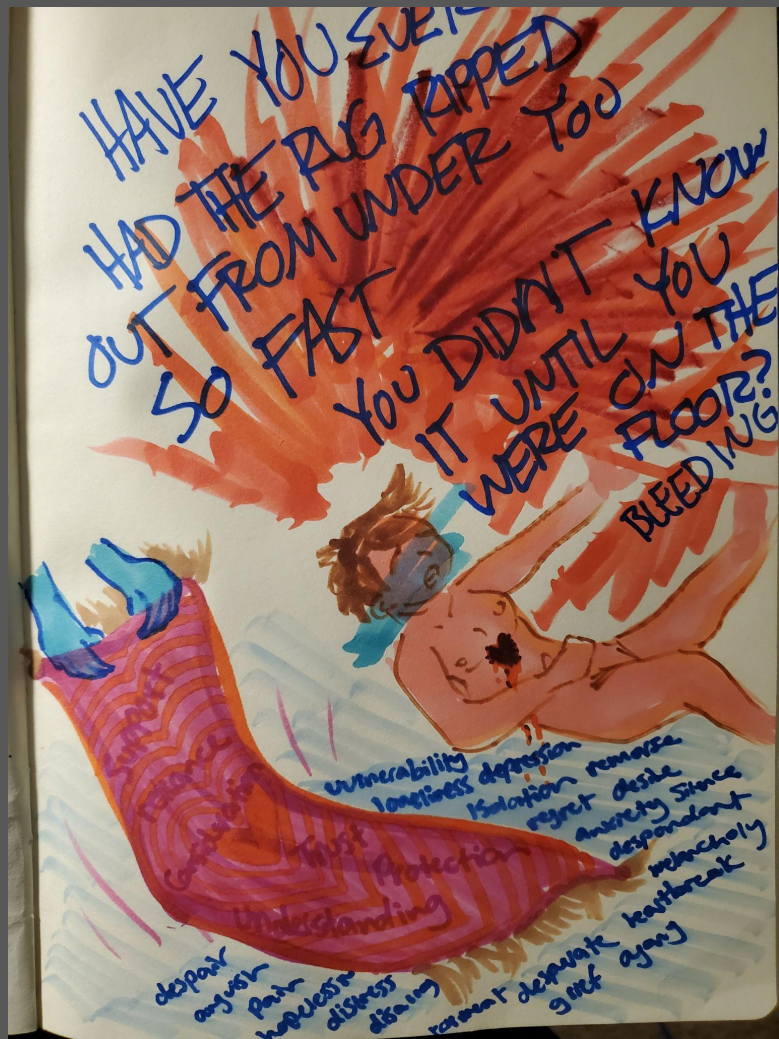

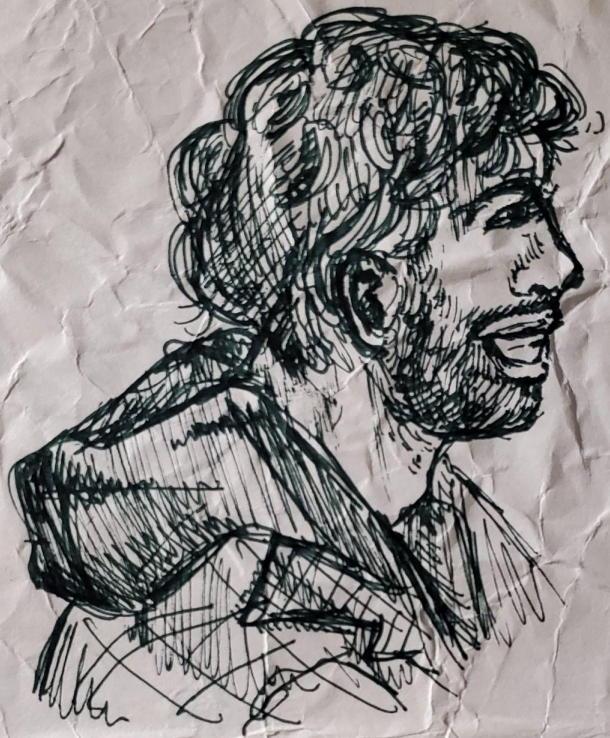


Footprints in the Sand

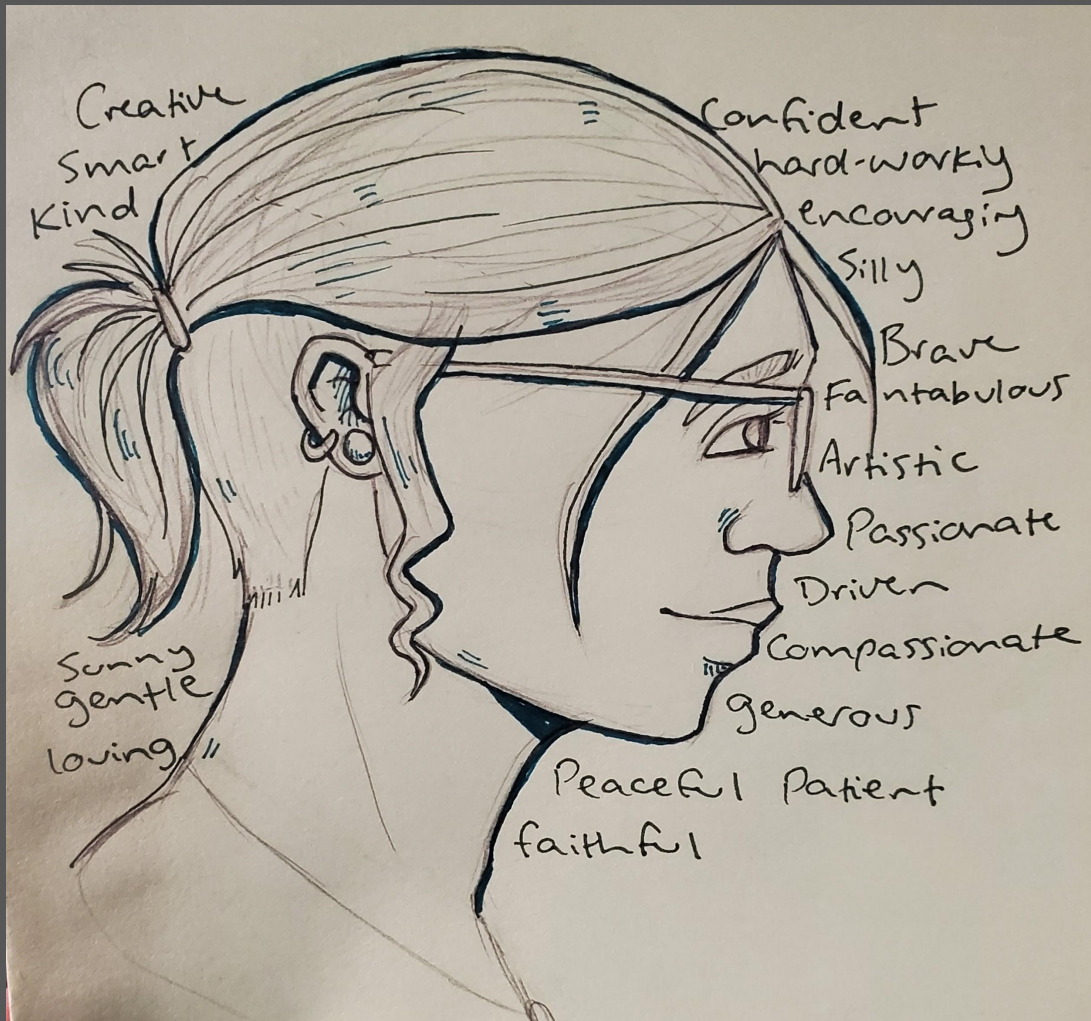

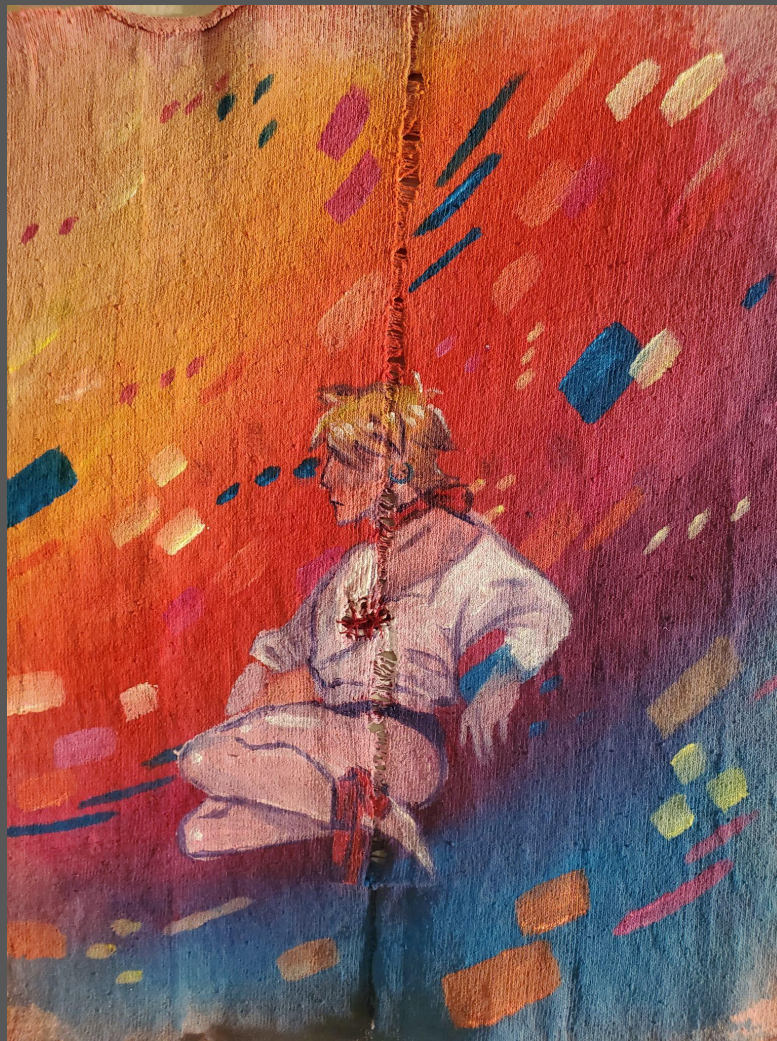
