 - Have a combined score of 800 (Verbal and Quantative) on the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) prior to November 2011, a combined score of 300 (Verbal and Quantitative) on the GRE if taken after November 2011, OR a scaled score of 378 on the Miller Analogies Test (MAT).
- International student applicants must submit updated GRE or MAT scores prior to admittance
