**Brass, woodwind and Percussion Majors: A minimum of 4 semester hours is required in instrumental organizations.**

**Satisfactory completion of:**

- 1) MUS 364 each semester of fulltime enrollment except for the semester of student teaching;
- 2) **Marching band (MUS 264) a minimum of the first two Fall semesters in attendance;**
- 3) A minimum of two semesters in MUS 263 level ensembles;
- 4) **A minimum of two semesters of participation in choral organizations.**

All of the above ensembles may be taken for credit or for 0 credit

**Guitar Majors** – A minimum of 4 semesters participation in MUS 364. Two semesters participation in guitar ensemble or an appropriate string ensemble. A minimum of two semesters participation in choral organizations.

**Piano Majors** – A minimum of 4 semesters participation in MUS 364. Two semesters of MUS 374 Accompanying Practicum. A minimum of two semesters participation in choral organizations.

**Organ Majors** – A minimum of 4 semesters participation in MUS 364. Two semesters of MUS 374 Accompanying Practicum. A minimum of two semesters participation in choral organizations.
