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Brass, Woodwind, & Percussion Majors: A minimum of 4 semester hours is required in instrumental organizations. Satisfactory completion of:

1. Music 364 each semester of full-time enrollment except for the semester of student teaching;

- 2. Marching Band (MUS 264) a minimum of the first two Fall semesters in attendance;
- 3. A minimum of two semesters in MUS 263 level ensembles;
- 4. A minimum of two semesters of participation in choral organizations. *All of the above ensembles may be taken for credit or for 0 credit

Guitar Majors—A minimum of 4 semesters participation in MUS 364. Two semesters participation in guitar ensemble or an appropriate string ensemble. A minimum of two semesters participation in choral organizations. **Piano Majors**—A minimum of 4 semesters participation in MUS 364. Two semesters of MUS 374 Accompanying Practicum. A minimum of two semesters participation in choral organizations.

Organ Majors—A minimum of 4 semesters participation in MUS 364. Two semesters of MUS 374 Accompanying Practicum. A minimum of two semesters participation in choral organizations.
