TEACH Grants provide assistance of up to \$4000 annually for students who intend to teach in a public or private secondary school that serves low-income students. A TEACH Grant recipient must teach at least four academic years within eight calendar years of completing the program of study for which he/she received a TEACH Grant. ***Failure to complete this service obligation will result in all amounts of the TEACH Grants received converting to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan.*** Interest will be charged from the date the grant(s) were originally disbursed. Eligibility is limited to students who meet all program requirements and are pursuing either a first undergraduate or Masters degree.
