

GOOGLE PHOTOS



You have several options to move your Google Photos.

Use Google Takeout:

This method lets you download all your photos and videos from Google Photos at one.

- Go to takeout.google.com
- Click **Deselect all**
- Scroll down and check **Google Photos**
- Click **Next Step**
- Under **Transfer to:**, choose one:
 - Send download link via email, or
 - Add to Dropbox, OneDrive, or Box
- Choose **file type (ZIP)** and **size (2GB or larger)**
- Click **Create export** or **Link accounts and create export**, depending on what delivery option you chose above
- When it is ready, you will receive an email from Google with a download link

Google Takeout ZIP:

- When you receive the email notification from Google Takeout, click **Manage Google Takeout request**
- From this link, click **Download**
- Find the downloaded .ZIP folder on your computer and extract the file
- Your photos and videos will be organized in folders by album
- Move them or organize them however you prefer

Dropbox, OneDrive, or Box:

When your files are ready, Google will upload them and send you an email with a link to their location.

Download selected albums or images manually:

- Go to photos.google.com
- Hover over the photos or albums you want and click the check mark
- Click the **three dots** and then **Download**

- Save the ZIP file to your computer
- Extract the ZIP file and save to your computer or upload to another storage location
