

# GOOGLE YOUTUBE



Follow the steps below to export or migrate your YouTube content.

## Use Google Takeout:

This method lets you download all your photos and videos from Google Photos at one.

- Go to [takeout.google.com](https://takeout.google.com)
- Click **Deselect all**
- Scroll down and check **YouTube and YouTube Music**
- Click **Next Step**
- Under **Delivery method**, choose **Send download link via email**:
- Choose **file type (ZIP)** and **size (2GB or larger)**
- Click **Create export** or **Link accounts and create export**, depending on what delivery option you chose above
- When it is ready, you will receive an email from Google with a download link

Google Takeout ZIP:

- When you receive the email notification from Google Takeout, click **Manage Google Takeout request**
- From this link, click **Download**
- Find the downloaded .ZIP folder on your computer and extract the file
- Each ZIP file will contain video folders, playlists folders, subscriptions folders, and such
- After downloading, you can re-upload them to another account or back them up

## Re-Upload Videos to a Personal YouTube Account

If you want your videos to remain public or accessible on YouTube:

- Download your videos using Takeout or directly from YouTube Studio
- Sign in to your personal Gmail account
- Go to [studio.youtube.com](https://studio.youtube.com)
- Click **Create** and then **Upload videos**
- Select the downloaded video files
- Update titles, descriptions, and thumbnails as needed

- Choose visibility (Public, Unlisted, Private)
- Click **Publish**

**Note:** Your videos will not retain views, likes, or comments from the original channel.
