Connecting to WLU-WiFi for Mac OS 10

If you are having trouble connecting to the WLU-WiFi wireless SSID, then it is possible, that you may need to manually add that network. Please see the steps below.

- 1. From the Apple menu, click System Preferences
- 2. Click on Network
- 3. Locate your Airport in the left-hand column and make sure that it is turned on.
- 4. Click the Advanced button
- 5. Under the Advanced pane, make sure that the "AirPort" tab is selected. You may currently have some wireless networks listed in the "Preferred Networks" box. Remove all associated WLU networks and then click on the "+" button
- 6. Enter the following
 - a. Network Name: WLU-WiFi
 - b. Security: WPA2 Enterprise
 - c. Username & Password
 - d. 802.1X is Automatic
 - e. Click Add
- 7. Back at the Airport preferences pane. WLU-WiFi should be listed. Click OK.
- 8. You can now click on Apply Now.
- 9. Your laptop will now try to connect.
- 10. You will most likely receive a warning about the certificate. This is normal. Click Continue and in a few seconds you should be connected to the WLU-WiFi network.
