Upper Division Qualification (UDQ) is a sophomore-level review that all music majors must complete. It is intended as a way to assess each students’ progress through the degree program at the midway point. To be eligible for UDQ, you must have Sophomore or Junior standing, successfully completed both MUS 104 and MUS 114, and successfully completed Applied Level 5. The UDQ Portfolio for Music Technology Majors must include your current unofficial Transcript, a detailed completion plan using this form, a detailed proposal for the Senior Project, 3 possible Internship scenarios, a personal statement which includes career goals and strategies for attaining these goals, 3 examples of concert recordings (completed in MUS 287 and/or 288), and other artifacts which support your career path. UDQ will include a portfolio review and an interview with the music faculty.
