

Spring Commencement

West Liberty University has been working diligently to make the Spring 2021 Graduation Ceremonies enjoyable for students and their families. It has been determined that three separate undergraduate ceremonies can be safely held on Saturday, May 8. The College of Education & Human Performance and College of Liberal Arts will have their ceremony at 9 am. The noon ceremony is dedicated to the College of Sciences and 3 pm is for the College of Arts & Communication, the Gary E. West College of Business, and the School of Professional Studies. A graduate degree ceremony is planned for May 7th. Along with students who have met the requirements for graduation this semester, graduates from the Class of 2020 will be permitted to take part in Commencement. In order to maintain everyone's safety, graduates are limited to two guests. All COVID-19 guidelines must be followed (masks, social distancing, and frequent hand washing). There will be no reception after any of the ceremonies but there will be a new group of WLU Alum able to celebrate their accomplishments.

Summer Courses & Preregistration

Pre-registration for summer and fall courses takes place between April 5-25. Students must meet with their academic advisor to receive their Alternate PIN for scheduling. Class standing determines the date students can access registration.
