Main Line Trail 1.1 Miles

Runs from the Commons Trailhead to the Weidman Run Trailhead. Orange ribbon marks the trail. To reach Nettle Run Trail, go out on Weidman Run Road and turn left.

Nettle Run Trail 0.5 Mile

Start at Weidman Run or take the Main Line Trail, a left on Hilltop Trail and then take a right at the Nettle Run Sign. Red ribbon marks the trail. To reach the Main Line Trail, go out on Weidman Run Road and turn right.

Inner Trail 0.3 Mile

Take the Mainline Trail and take a left at the sign for the Inner Trail. Pink ribbon marks the trail.

Hilltop Trail 0.13 Mile

This is a short trail between the Main Line trail and Nettle Run and Inner Trails. Purple ribbon marks the trail.

Commons Trailhead

Enter the trails north of the Commons complex on Residence Drive. Follow the signs for the Main Line trail.

Weidman Run Trailhead

Enter the trails off Weidman Run, approximately 0.5 east of Van Meter Way. There is very limited off-road parking. Take either Main Line trail to the left or Nettle Run Trail to the right.

Trail Rules

- No new trails are to be blazed, cut or otherwise established.
- Pets must be leashed at all times. Please clean up after your pet.
- Hunting, trapping, fishing, retrieval and gathering activities are not allowed.
- Removal or destruction of any object (plant, animal, rock or artifact) is prohibited.
- Possession or consumption of drugs or alcoholic beverages is not allowed on the trails.
- Camping is not permitted on the trails.
- No fires are allowed on the trails without authorization.
- Fireworks are prohibited on the trails.
- Unauthorized weapons are prohibited on the trails.
- No motorized vehicles of any kind are permitted on the trails.
- Trails are accessible from dawn until dusk daily, year-round.

See information above about connecting Main Line Trail and Nettle Run Trail. Use caution on Weidman Run Road.

Trails may be accessed at your own risk.

- The WLU trails are unsupervised. All visitors are responsible for their own safety. WLU is not responsible for injuries, damages, or theft.
- Always carry sufficient water and wear appropriate clothing, protective gear, and footwear.
- Be aware of natural hazards (dead trees, wildlife, rocks, running water, etc.).
- In case of emergency, dial 9-1-1. Trails are accessible from Weidman Run Road and Residence Drive.
